Catherine Mansfield, age 92, of Bowling Green, KY, died Monday, October 22, 2012, at Greenview Regional Hospital in Bowling Green, KY. The Simpson County, Kentucky native was a homemaker and member of Icy Sink Baptist Church, where she served as a Sunday School Teacher, Women's Missionary Society, Church Choir and Kitchen Committee.
