Dan Duff Taylor, 84, of Bowling Green died May 10, 2007, at a Bowling Green nursing home. The Bowling Green native worked for Pan American for more than 40 years and was the owner of Taylor Sanitation Co. He was a devoted member of Taylor Chapel A.M.E. Church, where he served as deacon, emeritus of the Trustees Board, emeritus of the Stewards Board and Laymans Organization. He was chosen Man of the Year for the A.M.E. 2004 Conference and was a Kentucky Colonel.
