



## Delmar McCarley

Delmar McCarley, 67, of Bowling Green died Aug. 5, 2008, at a Bowling Green nursing home. The Russellville native was the owner of Delmars and attended Loving Union CME Church. He served in the Air Force, attended Western Kentucky University and the University of Louisville and was a Peace Corps volunteer under the Kennedy administration from 1962-64 in Venezuela. He was an honorary Kentucky Colonel, assistant to the mayor of Louisville from 1969-75 and was director of Jefferson County Police Commission from 1975-77.

He was a son of the late John McCarley and Elizabeth Cooksey-McCarley-Browder. He was preceded in death by five brothers, Howard, William, John, James and Robert McCarley.

Memorial service is at 11 a.m. today at Burnam & Son Mortuary, with burial at 9 a.m. Tuesday in Kentucky Veterans Cemetery West in Hopkinsville.
