



Fred "Cliff" Ragland

November 4, 1921 - July 22, 2008

Fred Clifton Ragland, 86, of Rockfield died July 22, 2008, at The Medical Center. The Indianapolis native was a retired Army First Sergeant and served in the Army during the Vietnam War. He was a graduate of North Carolina College at Durham. He was also a member of Omega Psi Phi fraternity and American Legion and was a 33rd degree Mason.
