Gary Wayne Moore, 53, of Bowling Green died July 22, 2009, at University of Louisville Medical Center. The Bowling Green native was born Jan. 13, 1956. Gary served in the U.S. Navy and was awarded Meritorious Unit Commendation, Navy Expeditionary Medal in Lebanon, Good Conduct Award, Sea Service Deployment Award, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Navy E Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal and Bronze Star. He attended Mount Zion Baptist Church and was a graduate of Warren East High School. He was an employee of Huish Detergents.

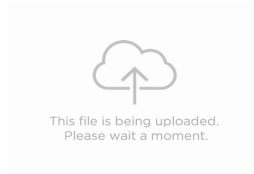
