Guinnetta Elizabeth Curd, 97, of Bowling Green died June 15, 2008, at Saints Mary & Elizabeth Hospital in Louisville. The Simpson County native was a domestic worker, a former member of Pleasant View Baptist Church and a member of State Street Baptist Church since 1945, where she served on the Kitchen Committee. She also was a missionary and a deaconette. She enjoyed quilting and working in the church.

She was a daughter of the late Charles Edison and Myrtle Turner Edison and the wife of the late Sam Curd. She was preceded in death by three brothers, Luther Edison, Earl Edison and Charles Edison.
