Joan D. Cosby-Rodgers, 67, of Bowling Green died April 9, 2008, in Bowling Green. She was a housekeeper, a child care provider and a member of Eleventh Street Baptist Church, where she served as Sunday school teacher, missionary, Willing Worker teacher, Nurse Aide president, Bible school teacher, Circle No. 2 Union District president and Upper Community Choir member. She was also a 1959 graduate of High Street School and Great Commission Community Bible College.

She was a daughter of the late James E. Cosby Sr. and Elizabeth Gumm-Cosby. She was preceded in death by three sisters, Evelyn Jean Cosby, Anna Elizabeth Cosby and Betty Cosby; and a brother, Herman Pete Cosby.
