



## Leon Johnson

September 13, 1947 - March 14, 2026

Leon Johnson was born on September 13, 1947, in St. Louis, Missouri, to the late Cass Johnson and Bertha Crowell Johnson. He entered into peaceful rest on March 14, 2026, at the age of 78 years, 6 months, and 1 day.

Leon received his early education at Garrison Elementary and later graduated from Lincoln Senior High School. On November 3, 1967, shortly after completing his studies, he was inducted into the United States Armed Forces. During his dedicated service, he earned the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, and the Bronze Star—honors that reflected his courage and commitment. Following his military service, Leon began a long and accomplished career with the General Motors Automotive Assembly Plant in St. Louis, Missouri. After 32 years of devoted work, he retired from the General Motors Corvette Plant in Bowling Green, Kentucky. On February 6, 1982, in Bowling Green, Leon married Janice Duck, beginning a partnership full of love, devotion, and laughter.

Leon was known for his generous spirit—often around a table filled with his home-cooked meals. He loved cooking for his family. He was a man who freely gave his time, always ready to lend a helping hand whenever it was needed. A man of faith, Leon was a member of Our Lord's Temple Church and Lodge AL#28, Prince Hall Mason. In his leisure time, he found joy in fishing and hunting. He was also an avid bowler who once achieved the rare

accomplishment of a perfect 300 game.

Leon leaves behind a legacy of love, strength, and kindness. He will be fondly remembered by his devoted wife, Janice Duck Johnson; his children, Edward Johnson, Tony (Juli) Duck, and Lisa Wilbourn; and his eight cherished grandchildren. He is also survived by his siblings, Tommie (Calvin) Randolph, Leroy (Brenda) Johnson, Bernard (Mira) Johnson, Maurice (Ann) Johnson, Tyrice (Rose) Johnson, and Vanessa Fulton; three brothers-in-law, a sister-in-law, numerous relatives, and a host of friends who will forever honor his memory.
