Marsha Diane Nixon, 42, of Bowling Green died April 16, 2009, at The Medical Center. She was employed by United Parcel Service and was co-founder and assistant pastor of Powerhouse Ministries. She was also founder of Praise Team, Soldier Outreach, Young Ladies of Destiny and A Mighty Voice Ministries. She was author of Instructions the Book God Told Me to Write, and she enjoyed organizing, writing, spiritual counseling, teaching the Word and spending time with family and friends.

She was the daughter of Zachariah Nichols of Bowling Green, who survives, and the late Virginia Murrell Nichols. She was preceded in death by her grandparents: George Nichols Sr. and Macy Nichols, and Jesse Staten and Buford Murrell.

Funeral is at 1 p.m. Tuesday at Cottage Chapel Seventh-day Adventist Church, with burial in Fairview Cemetery. Visitation is from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at Burnam & Son Mortuary.

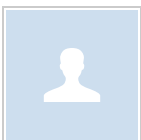
