



## Norman N. Davidson

December 28, 1926 - September 20, 2009

Norman Neal Davidson, 82, of Park City died Sept. 20, 2009, at T.J. Samson Community Hospital in Glasgow. The Park City native was born Dec. 28, 1926. He was the owner/operator of Park City Service Cleaners for more than 20 years. He served in the Army from 1954-56 and was a post World War II veteran of the Korean War. He was a member of Zion Hill Baptist Church in Park City, where he also served as chairman of the Deacon Board Emeritus, past president of the choir, past Sunday school superintendent, past Sunday school teacher, past church clerk, past treasurer and member of the Brotherhood. He served on the City Council of Park City for 24 years and was a Kentucky Colonel.

He was a son of the late Harry and Bessie Davidson. He was preceded in death by five brothers: Robert, Harry, Marvin, Phillip and Clifford Davidson; a sister: Pauline Woods; and special nephews, Paul Woods and Elvin Woods (Dorothy).

Funeral is at 1 p.m. Saturday at Zion Hill Baptist Church in Park City, with burial in Hayden Cemetery in Park City. Visitation is from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the church.
