Rena Parrish-Carter, 98, of Oakland, died Jan. 6, 2010, at her residence. The Warren County native was born March 11, 1911. She was a member of Oakland Mount Zion Baptist Church and had served as a former choir and missionary member. She was a domestic worker for many years.
