



Rev. Roy L. Anthony

May 8, 1928 - January 3, 2010

The Rev. Roy L. Anthony, 81, of Bowling Green, died Jan. 3, 2010, at The Medical Center. The Bowling Green native was born May 8, 1928. He was pastor of Jackson Baptist Church for 40 years, attended Oakland Elementary School and was an employee of Honey Crust Bakery for many years. He worked at Durbins Department Store for 20 years and the Houchens Foundation.

He was a son of the late Porter Anthony and Ora Lewis Anthony and the husband of the late Mary Helen Anthony.
