Taron Ray Britt was born on October 14th, 1963, in Los Angeles, CA to Belle Harden and the late Raymond Britt. He was immersed in the Seventh-Day community and attended South Bay Jr. Academy, Los Angeles Union Adventist School, and Lynwood Adventist Academy. In 1981, he graduated from Compton Senior High School and began attending Los Angeles Trade Technical School shortly thereafter, where he was trained as an electrician.
